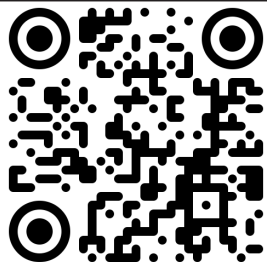

Revolutionary War

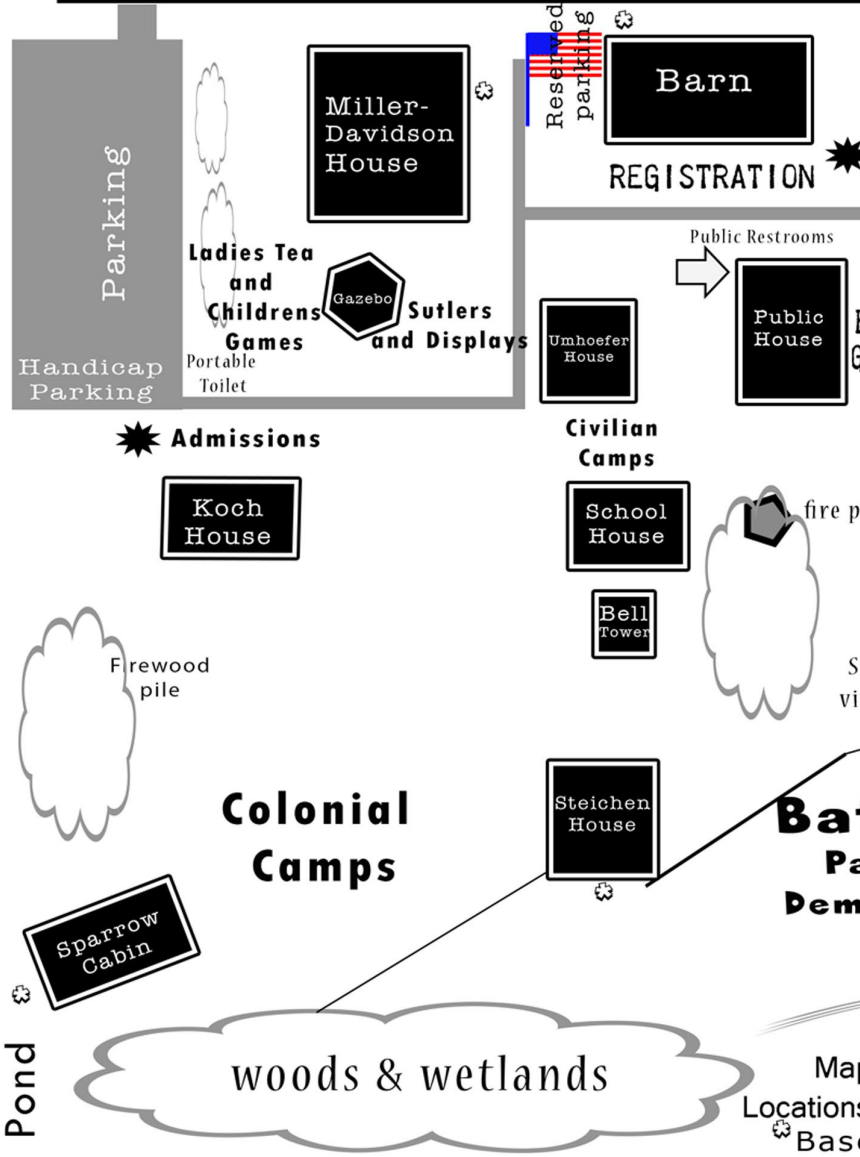

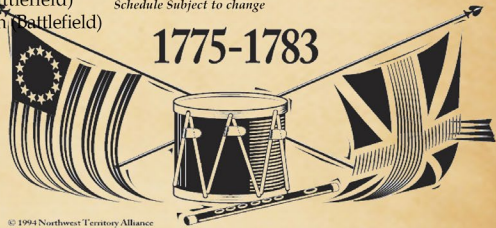

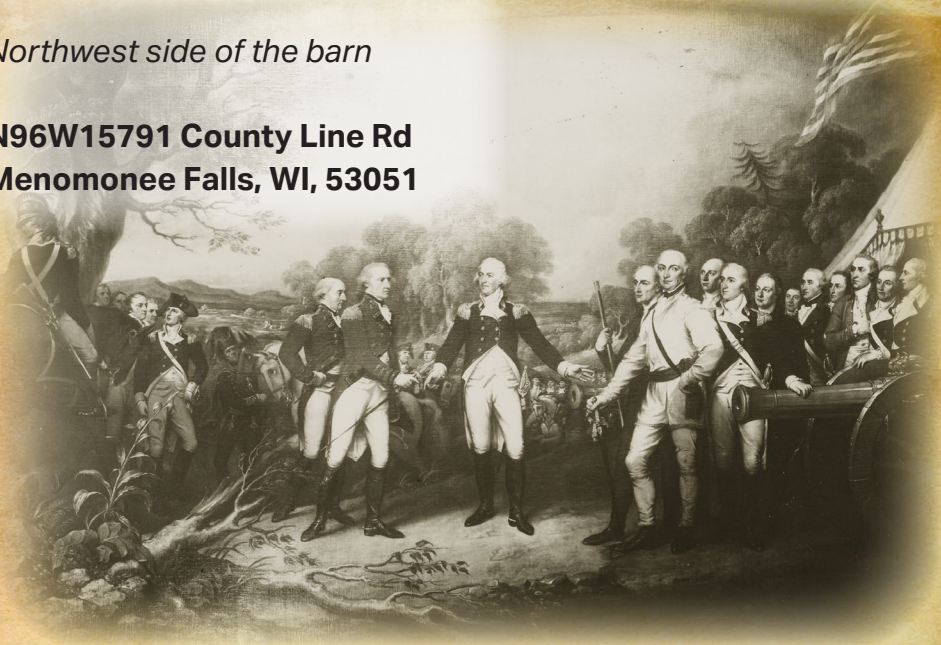
